WHERE? Camp Bird is in Northern Wisconsin, Marinette County, half-way between Crivitz and Mountain, just off Highway W. Complete information will be sent with the acceptance letter, including what to bring, when to come and detailed directions as to how to get to camp and what to do when you get there.

Camp Bird is leased from Marinette County Forestry Department. It has full facilities including shower rooms and flush toilets plus all the other necessary buildings for a full camping experience including a beautiful sand beach in a spring-fed lake. Nine campers and a counselor are housed in each cabin.

WHAT CAN I DO? A full day and evening programs are directed by competent and experienced staff, from Bible discussions and music periods for part of the morning to swimming, hiking, nature study, games, softball, handicraft, volleyball, archery, boating and of course swimming and time for just plain relaxing and enjoying Christian fellowship with fellow WELS members and dedicated staff people.

CAN I COME? If you are in grades 5-8 in the 2011-12 school year, you are eligible. In accordance with Federal Law and U.S. Department of Agriculture policy, this institution is prohibited from discriminating on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability. WHAT MUST I DO TO APPLY? Fill out the attached application blank completely. HAVE YOUR PASTOR OR ELEMENTARY LUTHERAN SCHOOL OR SUNDAY SCHOOL PRINCIPAL AND YOUR PARENTS OR GUARDIAN SIGN IT. Registration will be limited to one week per camper. ONLY THREE PEOPLE may sign up to be together, but their names must be on each others application and not on someone else's application. Please note also which week you would be able to attend if the week of your choice is filled. Medical certificates and how to fill them out will be sent with the acceptance letter.

WHAT IS THE COST? \$150.00 for the first child and \$110 for each additional child in the family. A registration fee of \$100 for the first child and \$60 for the second or third child must accompany the application. The additional \$50 per child is due when they arrive at camp and register. Registration begins about 2:00 p.m. each Sunday and all campers should be out of camp by 3:00 p.m. on Friday of their week. There is a \$30 charge for non-medical refunds. No refunds after July 1, unless it is medical.

WHEN SHOULD I MAIL IN MY APPLICATION? Applications may be mailed anytime. They will be received on a first come, first serve basis. Fee includes a T-shirt. Please indicate your size on the Application blank. Size is guaranteed if application is received by June 20.
